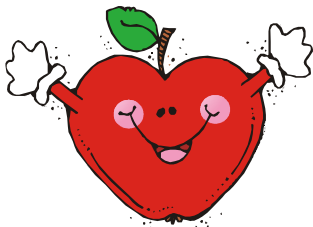
A Peek at the Week

A Note from the Teacher



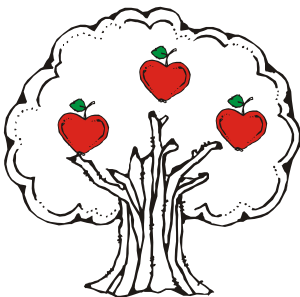
As we study apples this week, we will want discover that there are many different sizes, colors, and tastes! If you are able, please send in an apple with your child any day this week.

Book of the Week Mr. Brown's Magnificent Apple Tree

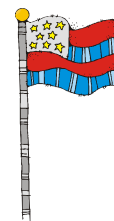


Things you can do at home:
