The Thanksgiving program is also soon approaching. Your child will need to have a Pilgrim or Indian costume for the play. Now is a good time to look for costumes! ☺

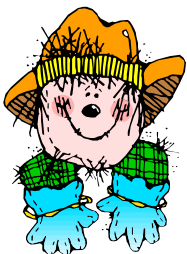
This week we will be talking about Veterans' Day and American symbols. We will also continue to be in the fall spirit as we read and

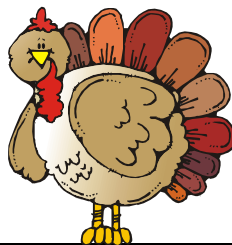
