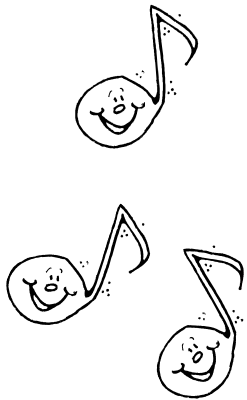

I don't like Thanksgiving day!

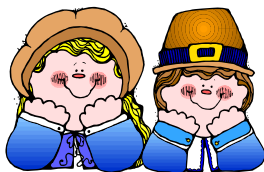
A Note from the Teacher
